Affectionately nicknamed "The Castle" , the Royal Village is the grande dame of condominiums in Fort McMurray. Open concept kitchen features a sit up peninsula, stainless steel appliances and real wood custom cabinetry. Ten foot ceilings with crown moldings, in floor heat and double drywall for sound make these a truly unique condo living experience.
